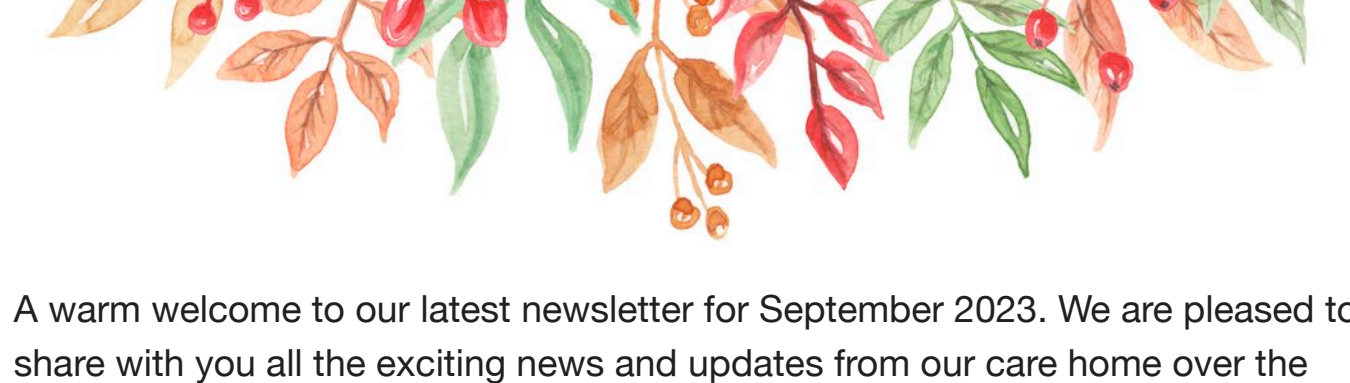


## Welcome To Our Newsletter

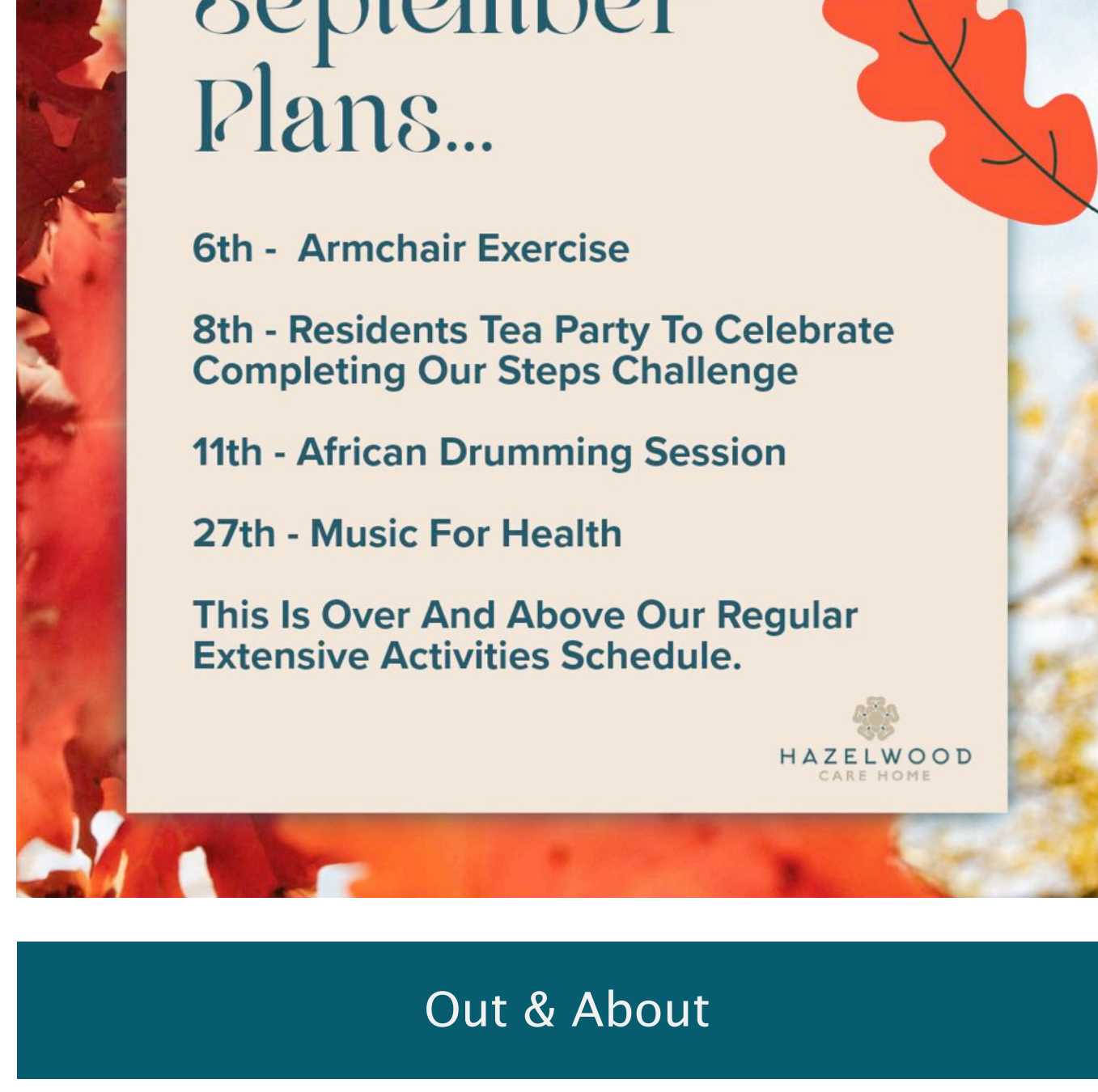

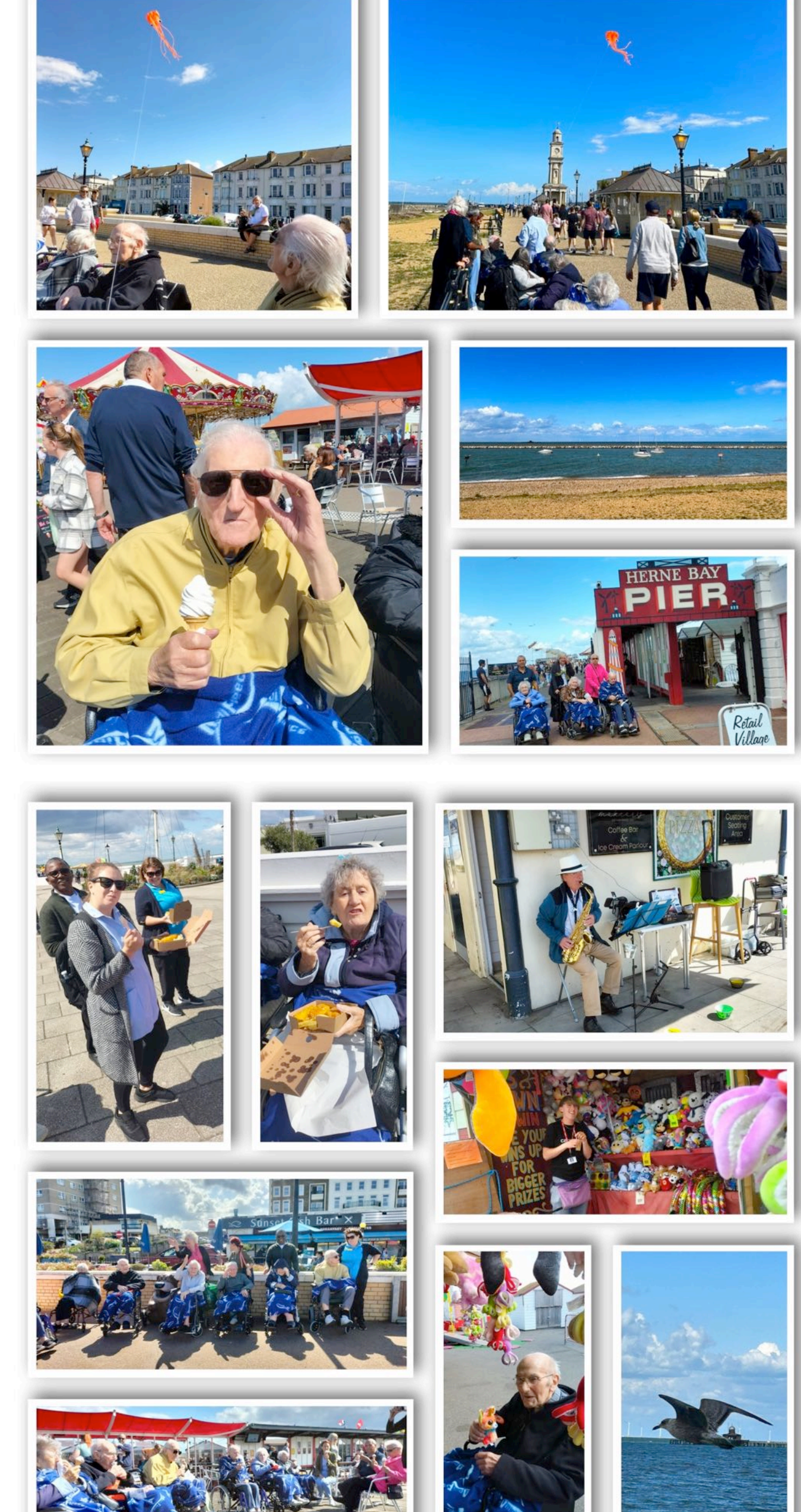

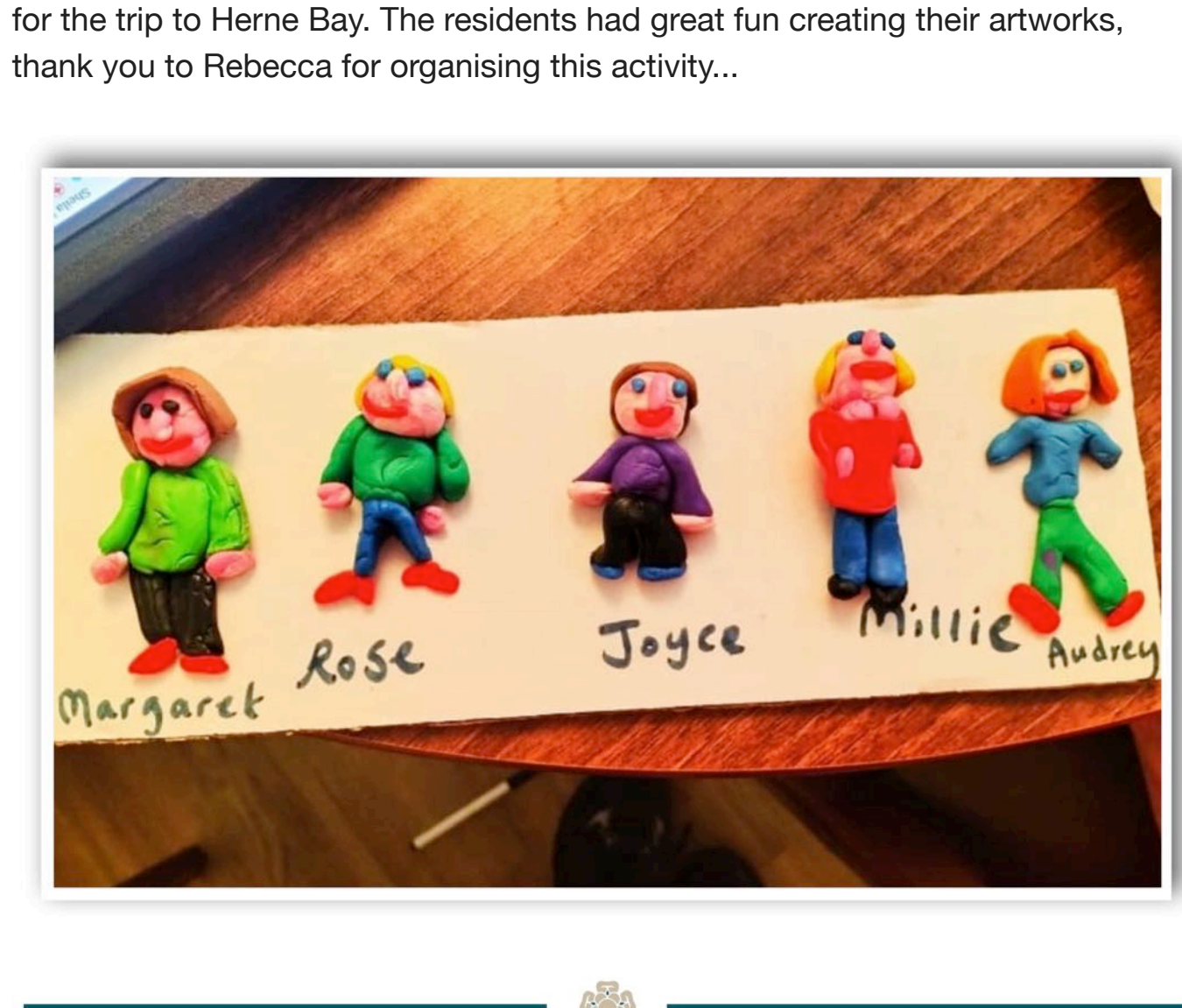
## Fresh Air & Sunshine

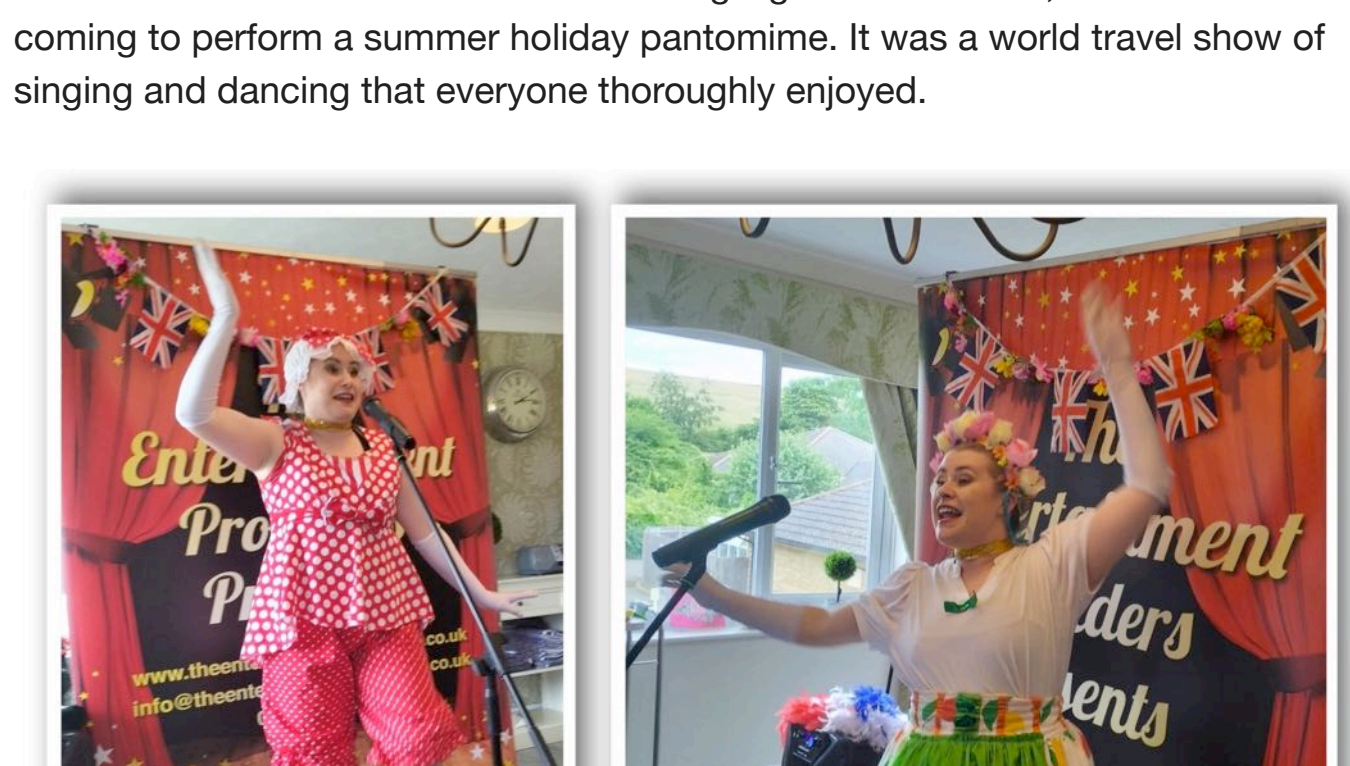


## Musical Entertainment



## Singing & Dancing

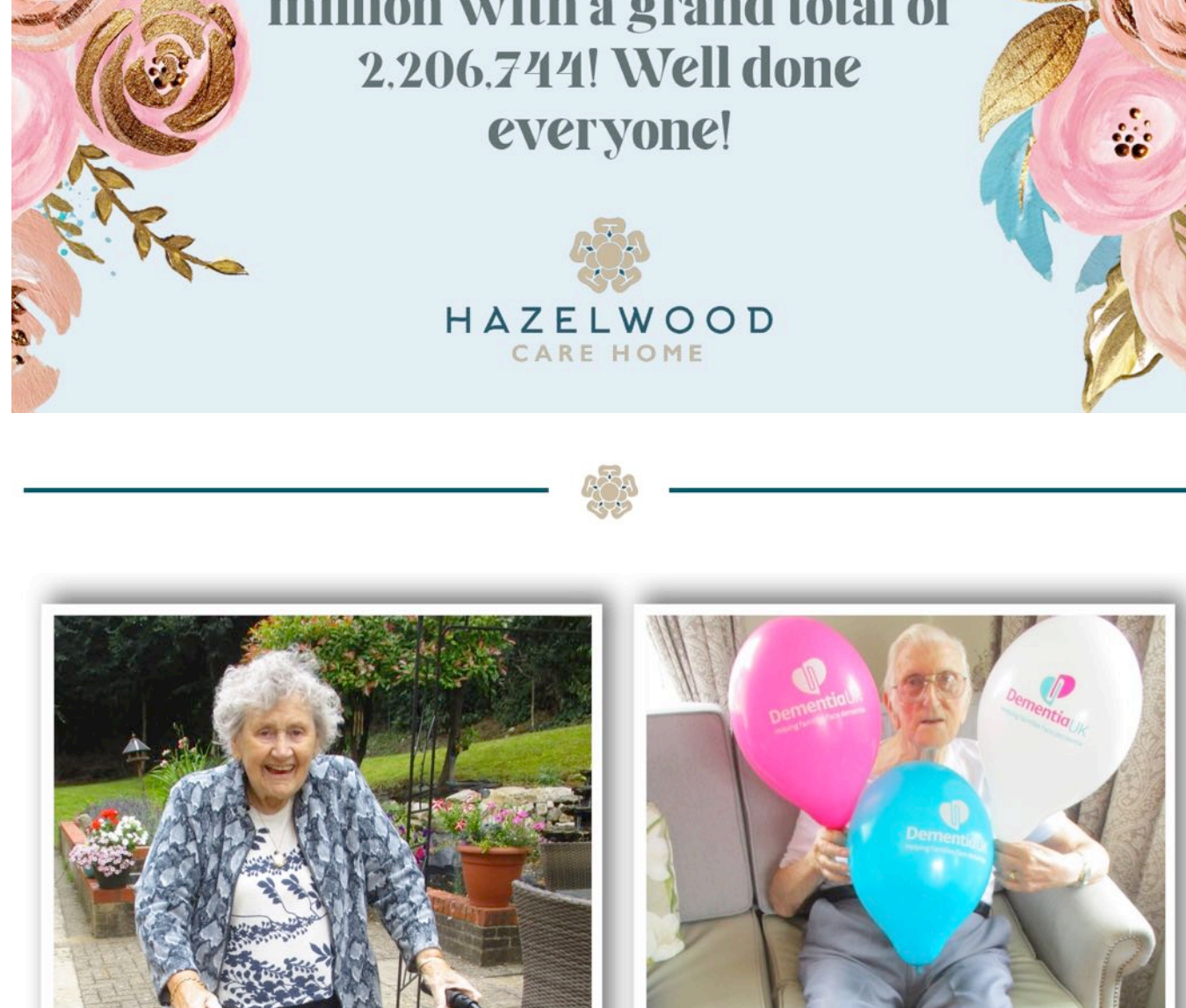

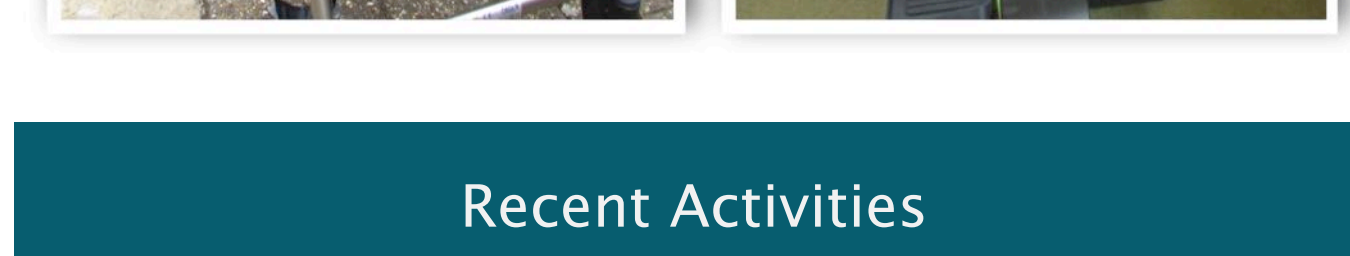
Our residents had a lovely sunny afternoon in the garden with a 1960's singer. We had a singalong and dance and enjoyed ice creams to cool us all down.

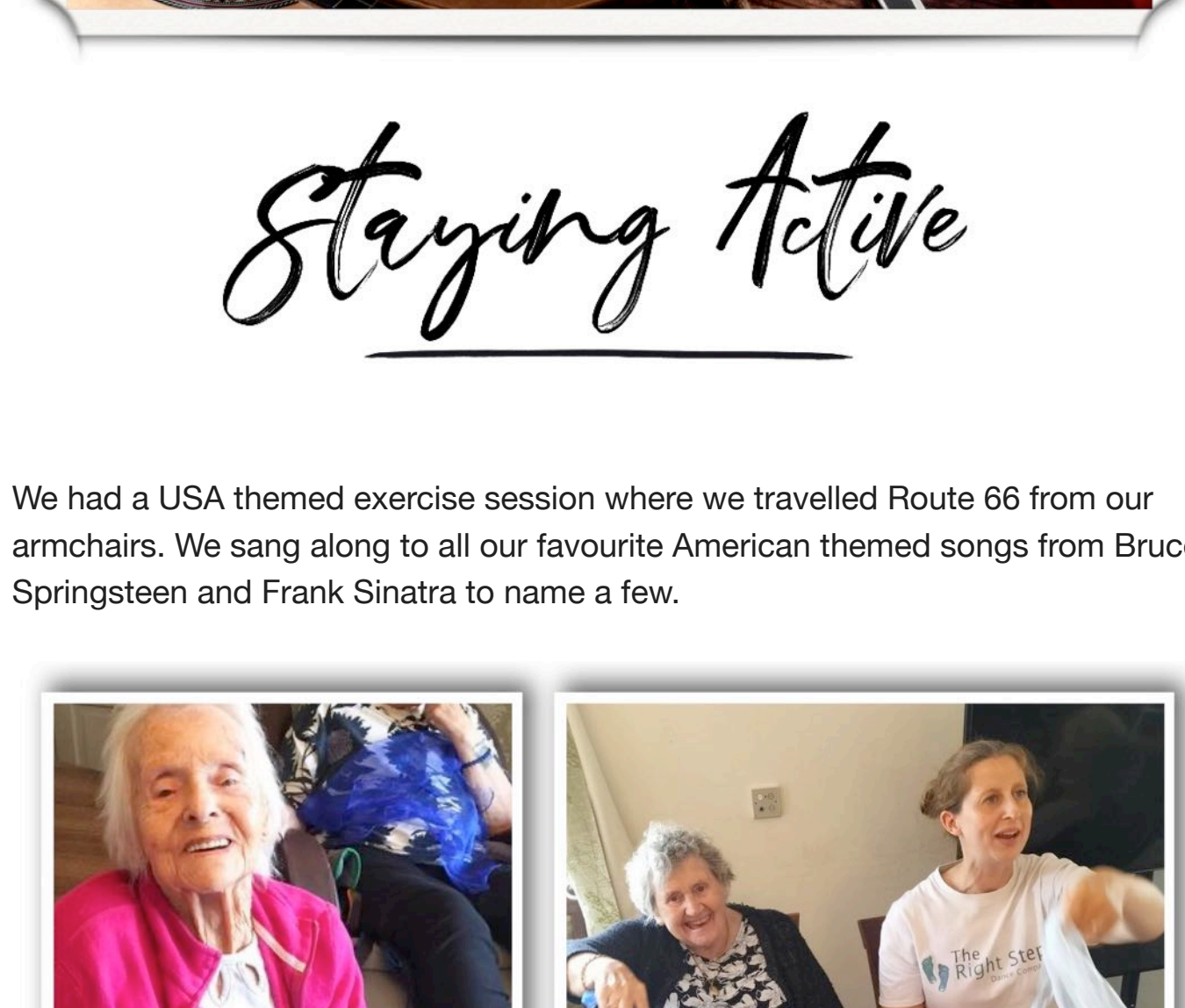

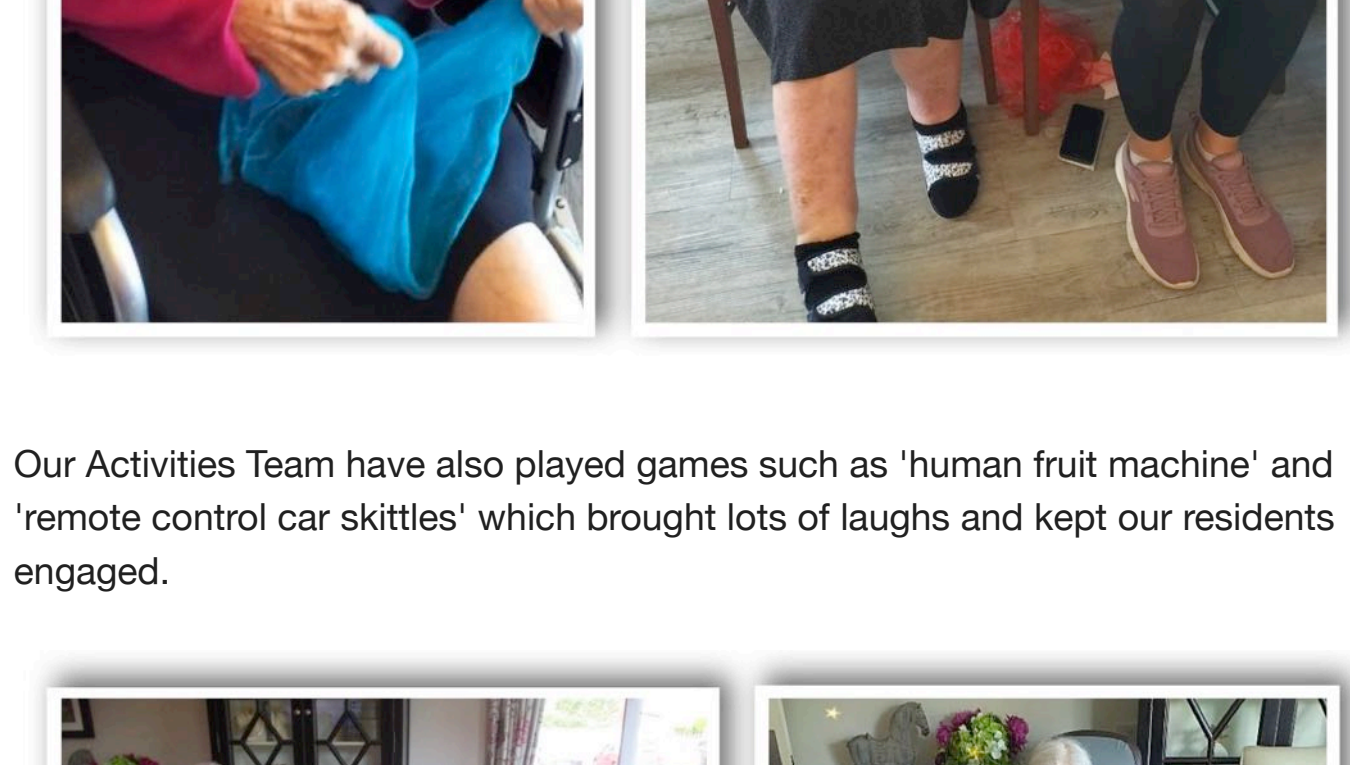


## Staying Active

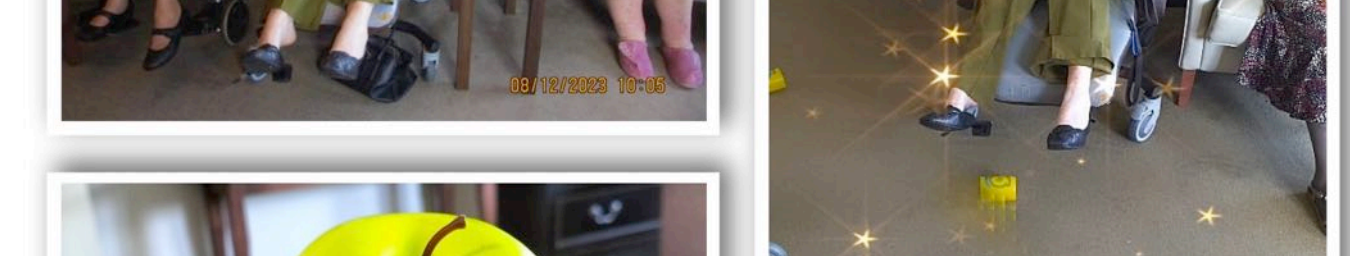
