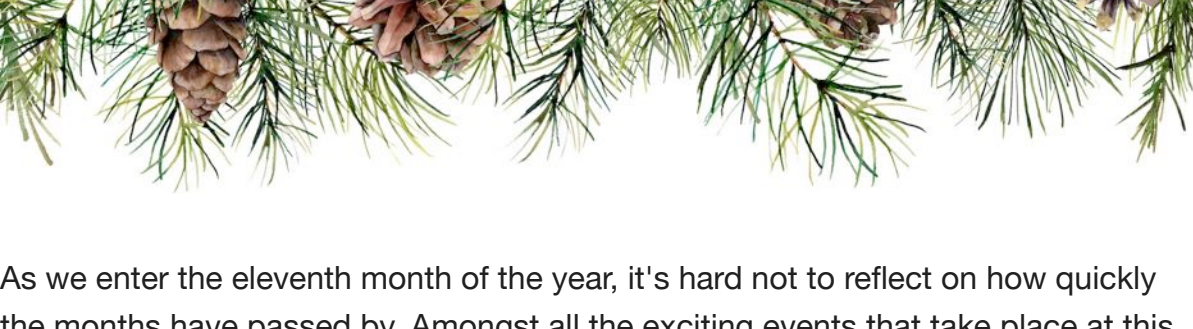


Welcome To Our Newsletter

We continued with the calm tone in the afternoon as we got crafty. Collecting autumn leaves and making leaf people...

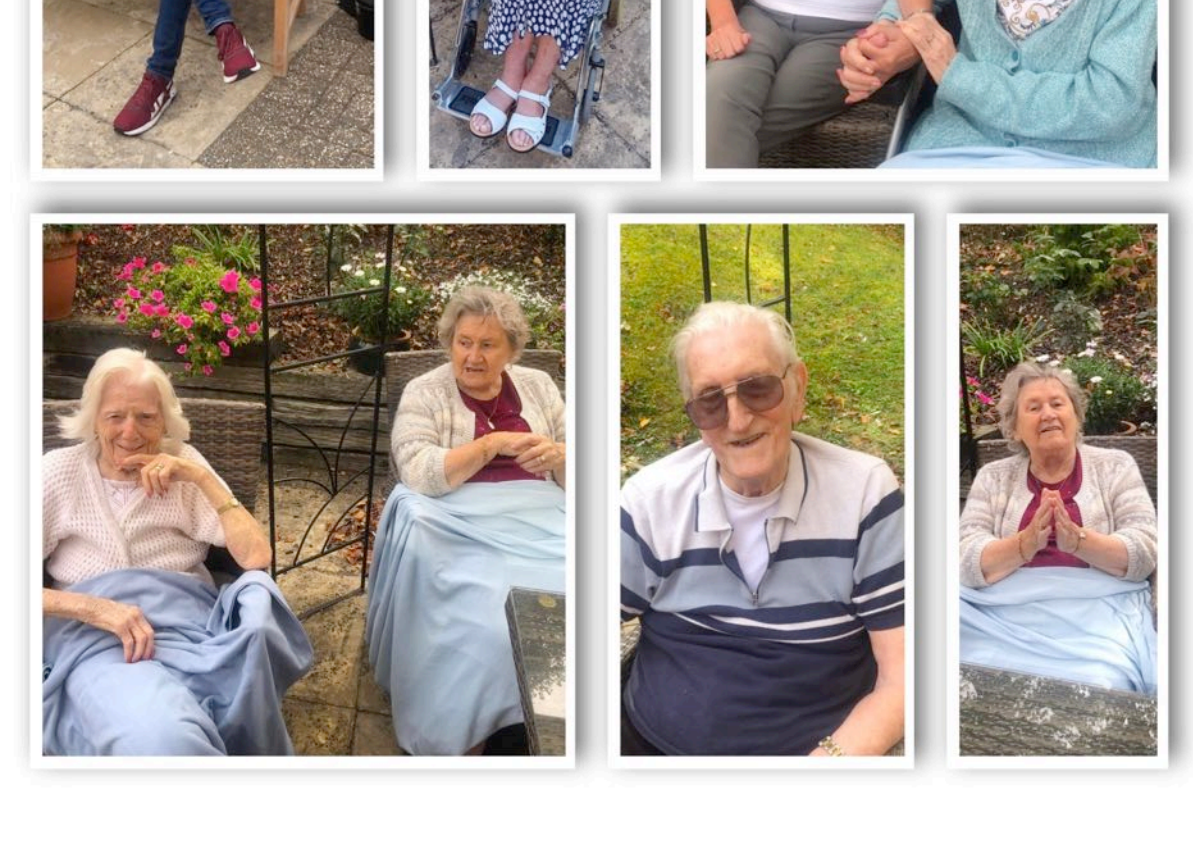

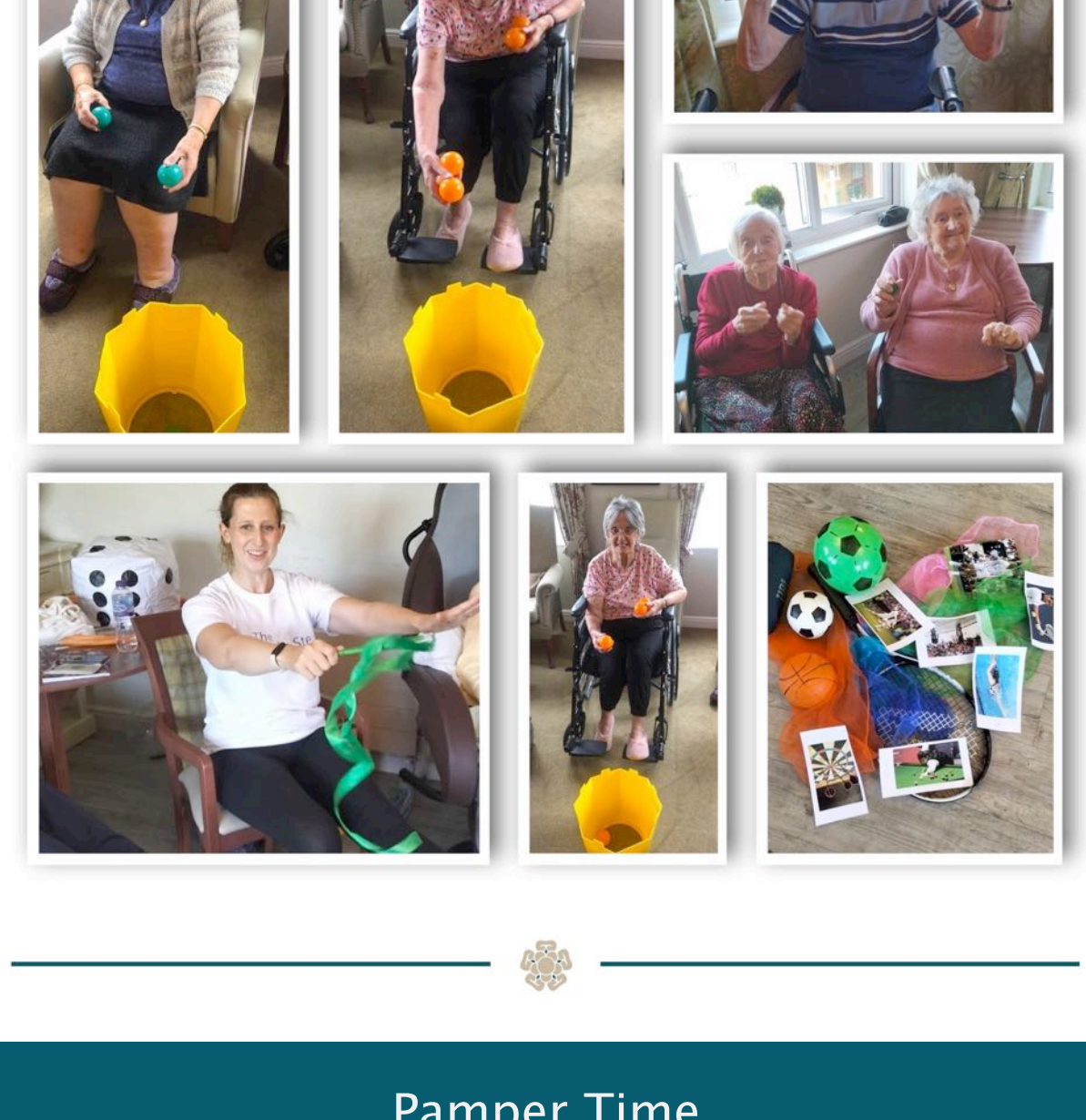


Singing & Dancing

We had our Armchair Exercise session with a sporty theme. Ball games are great for coordination and we had a few giggles too...



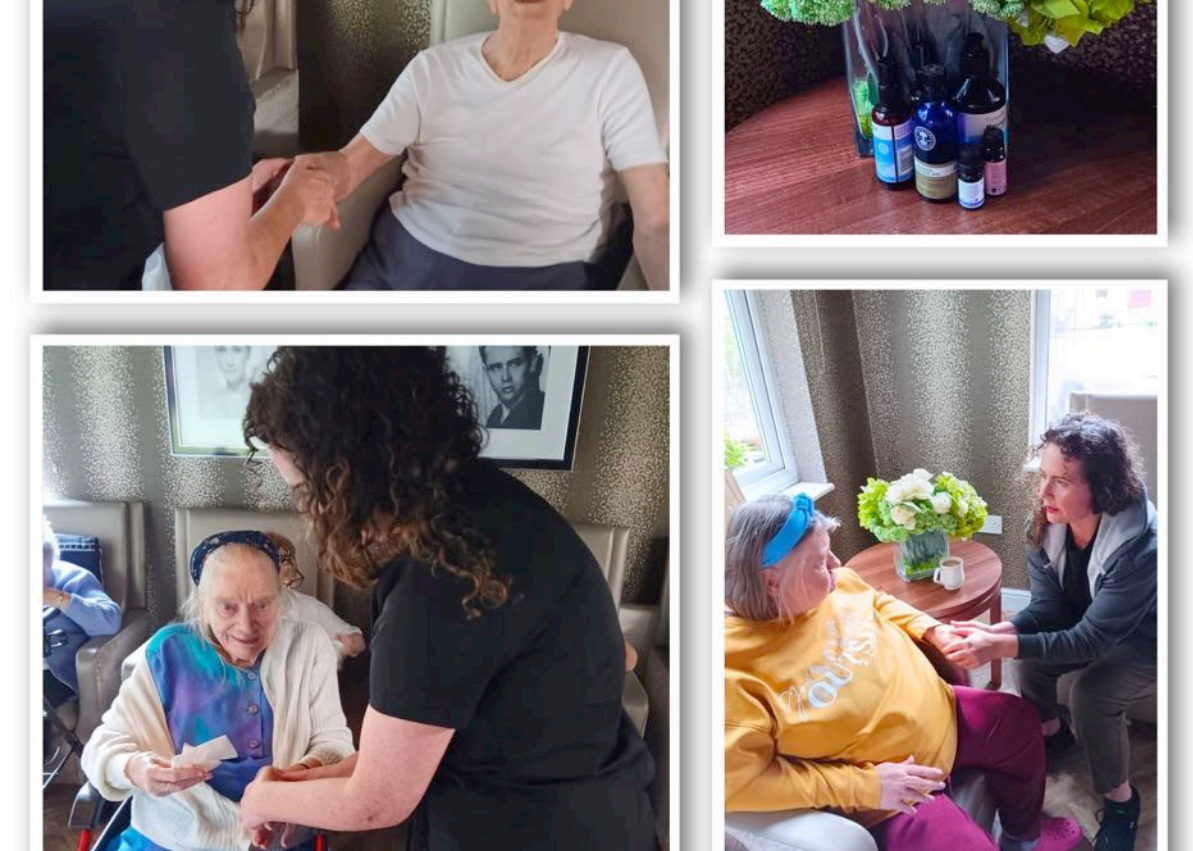
Pamper Time



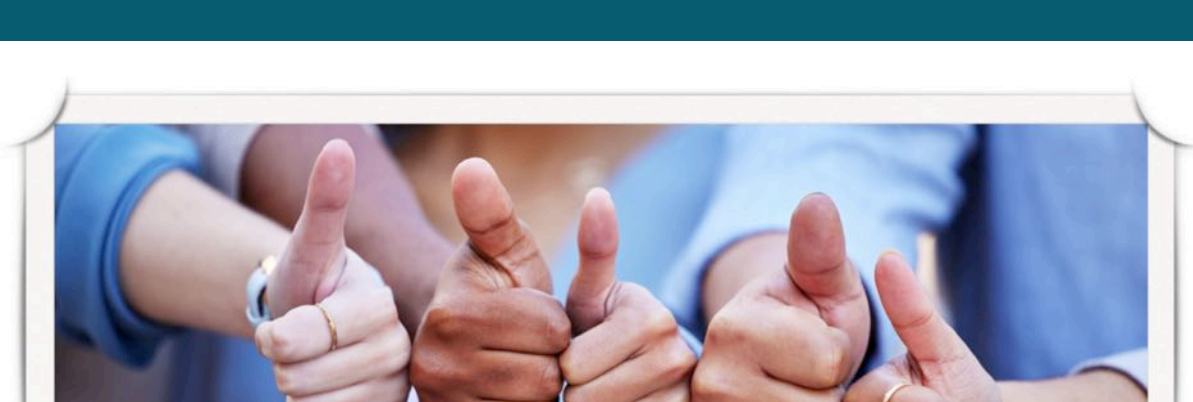
And Relax...

We are proud of our staff, and we appreciate their hard work and dedication to our residents.

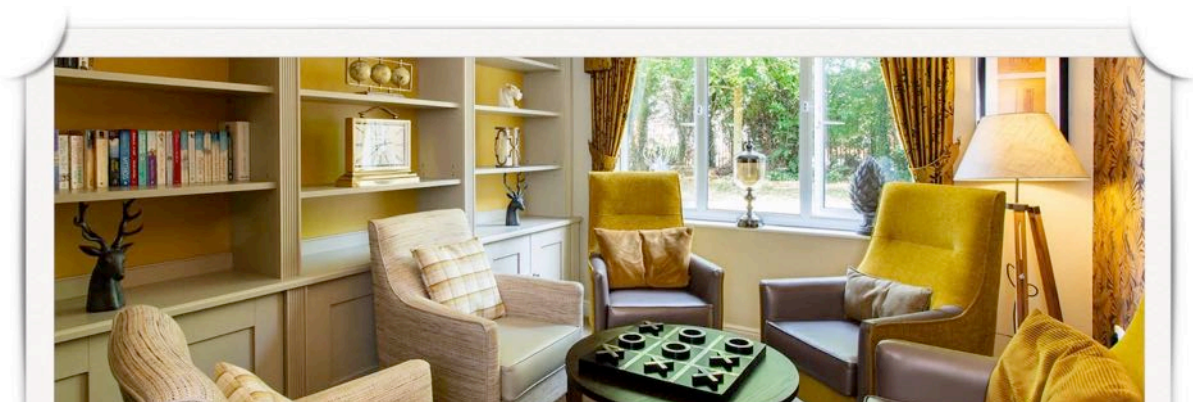
We reintroduced our "Star of the Month" award and our staff have all been voting. Our first winner was Tanya, one of our Carers and we congratulate her on her achievement.

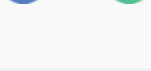
